



Dear Centennial Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for your continuous support of our school. As the first Quarter ends, we always evaluate where we could become better as a school. We have noticed that our student tardies are above average. Centennial believes if students are in class on time that we will increase students learning. Therefore, we have adjusted our tardy system which we think will increase student awareness of the importance of being on time.

First, every time your student is late you will receive an automated message from the school alerting you of their tardiness at the end of each day. Second, we have updated our own tardy tracking system to provide a faster response to help correct the tardiness. Thank you for your support in making sure that your student is on time.

Our new system is as follows:

- Students will be rewarded if they should get two or less tardies per Quarter. (We appreciate students who are making the effort to be on time.)
- 3 tardies is a lunch detention at school.
- 6 tardies is after school detention on Wednesday from 2:40pm to 4:00pm. Also, there will be no activity night for the student.
- 7 tardies is another lunch Detention.
- 8 tardies is Lunch Detention and Wednesday Detention.
- 9 tardies is parent meeting and Professional Development Day Detention or Suspension if student is a no show.
- 10 tardies or more, no field trips and grade level rewards.
- After 11 tardies Lunch Detention and Wednesday Detention each tardy.
- Students will be rewarded if they should get two or less tardies per Quarter.
