Writing

- 4 pages of writing/ week (standard homework expectations)

Prompts will be sent and a page to write on will be posted on Google Classroom (notebook will be digital)

- 1 poem/ week

Poetry unit will be on Google Classroom and poems will be drafted directly on the lesson (directions are included weekly)

- 1 Khan Academy grammar lesson/week

Specific lessons will be posted on Google Classroom for completion

- Weekly spelling practice sheet

All work will be posted on Sundays by 11:59 p.m., beginning on Sunday, March 22.

- (#1 item to do) Check Google Classroom (GC) weekly for specific Earth Science materials to complete.
- Read one article each week that involves Earth Science and Summarize the article in a paragraph on GC. I will have several posted if you cannot find one. "Newsela.com" is a great resource.
 - Rock & cave formations
 - Earthquake locations, magnitudes, destruction, etc.
 - Volcano formations, eruptions, etc.
- Watch the news at least once a week about the COVID-19 virus and Summarize the news cast on GC
 - What effect is the virus having?
 - What are doctors and health experts saying?
